

NAZARETH BOROUGH COUNCIL--REORGANIZATION MEETING--JANUARY 5, 2026

The Bi-Annual Reorganization Meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Mayor Lance E. Colondo.

Mayor Lance E. Colondo administered the Oath of Office to Councilpersons Carl R. Strye Jr., Cindy Corpora, Robert DelNero and Christopher D. Crook all for four (4) year terms. All four (4) duly elected Councilpersons have presented their "Certificates of Election" and their notarized "Affidavits of Residency" to Borough Secretary/Treasurer Paul Kokolus. The Secretary/Treasurer confirms receipt of all required documents.

Mayor Lance E. Colondo administers the Oath of Office to Chief of Police, Randall S. Pompei Jr.. Chief Pompei becomes Nazareth's tenth Chief of Police since 1946.

Mayor Lance E. Colondo administers the Oath of Office to new Police Sergeants Tyler Ferri and Brandon Rader.

Mayor Lance E. Colondo administers the Oath of Office to duly elected Tax Collector John Muscler, elected to serve a four year term.

Mayor Colondo administers the Oath of Office to Fire Chief Jerry Johnson, and Second Assistant Fire Chief Frank Betz III. 1st Assistant Fire Chief Joseph Ianovale could not be present and will be sworn at a later date.

Mayor Colondo administers the Oath of Office to Special Fire Police Officers Heather Kromer and Kerry Frey. Officer Raymond Fogel was not present and will be sworn at a later date.

Mayor Colondo asked for nominations for the Office of President of Borough Council.

Robert DelNero moved to nominate Daniel Chiavaroli for Council President. No further nominations were made and eight (8) Councilpersons assented to Chiavaroli's election as Council President. There was one (1) abstention.

Mayor Colondo then turned the gavel over to new Council President Daniel Chiavaroli.

Daniel Chiavaroli asked for nominations for the Office of Vice President of Borough Council. Carl A. Fischl moved to nominate Carl R. Strye Jr. for Council Vice President. Michael Kopach seconded the nomination. No further nominations were made and a voice vote followed. Eight (8) councilpersons assented to Strye's election to the office of Council Vice President. There was one (1) abstention.

Daniel Chiavaroli asked for nominations for the Office of President "Pro-Tem" of Council who would conduct business in the absence of the Council President and Vice President.

Kayla Green moved and Lauren Pellegrino seconded a motion to appoint Christopher D. Crook as "President Pro-Tem" of Nazareth Borough Council.

The motion passed unanimously. There was one (1) abstention.

Cindy Corpora moved and Kayla Green seconded a motion to appoint Alfred S. Pierce as Solicitor for the Borough of Nazareth. Pierce's nomination was unanimously approved.

Kayla Green moved and Michael Kopach seconded a motion to appoint Michael Shallock and Keystone Consulting Engineers as Borough Engineer. No further nominations were offered. A voice vote followed and Michael Shallock's nomination was approved unanimously.

Kayla Green moved and Carl A. Fischl seconded a motion to adjourn the Reorganization Meeting at 6:24 P.M..
